

The following are the current positions within Command Division and a description of the duties and responsibilities of each. All candidates for each position must be graduates from Lotus Fleet Academy, and must be approved by the Commanding Officer of Command Division.

Media Developer (Tier 3)

Takes direction from the Publications Director on which projects are to be completed and in what order.

Reports to the Publications Director as instructed on the progress of any outstanding media projects.

A candidate for this position should have experience with Media production including the use of Media software such as Photoshop along with web design programs, like Adobe Dreamweaver, Adobe Edge, Typekit, Google Web Fonts, MUSE, or Fireworks.... i.e. experience working with web-based design to create features for the fleet website; which we currently have ideas prepared for implementation.

Newsletter Writer (Tier 2)

Responsible for producing stories for the fleet newsletter at the direction of the newsletter editor or senior newsletter writer.

A candidate for this position should be able to accept article assignments and meet deadlines as given by the Newsletter Editor, along with having initiative to come up with ideas as well.

Recruitment and Retention Officer (Tier 2)

Assists with all recruitment and retention activities including but not limited to in-game recruitment, the STO forum thread, and threads on any other fan or community sites.

Candidates for this position should be friendly, outgoing, social and prepared to represent Lotus Fleet to the Star Trek community at large.

An Interview With Vice Admiral Jett Ski

1. *Where are you from?*

Originally, Southern New Jersey just east of Philadelphia. Then, San Diego California. Currently Phoenix Arizona

2. *What is your position in the Fleet?*

Commanding Officer of the Command Division

3. *When did you join Lotus Fleet?*

February 2011

4. *Lotus Fleet has often been described as more than just a gaming fleet, what does that mean to you?*

To begin to answer this, I first go back to Star Trek's creator.

Gene Roddenberry himself was more than merely a TV producer and the creator of Star Trek — he was a futurist who had a keen vision about the potential future of mankind in the midst of some very turbulent times in our society.

5. *What is your favorite Star Trek series?*

Star Trek (TOS)

6. *What is your favorite Star Trek Movie?*

The wrath of Khan, followed VERY closely by The Undiscovered Country.

7. *Who is your favorite Star Trek captain and why?*

James Tiberius Kirk

Resourceful:

In his one-on-one battle with the Gorn Captain, Kirk remembers an old formula for gunpowder and is able to construct a makeshift cannon: using sulfur, coal, potassium nitrate, diamonds, and a bamboo-like plant. Doing all of this while injured and being pursued.

Compassion/Mercy:

In the same episode, he refuses to deal a fatal blow to his opponent; realizing also that the Federation could have placed a colony where it didn't belong.

Intelligence/Always learning:

"You know the greatest danger facing us is ourselves, an irrational fear of the unknown. But there's no such thing as the unknown— only things temporarily hidden, temporarily not understood."

His best friend Gary Mitchell describe him as a walking stack of books, yet he had a high degree of common sense and could improvise when required.

Cunning/Risk-taker:

Many examples: like the Corbomite maneuver when facing death, or in tricking the Klingons to beam into a self-destructing Enterprise to even the odds in The Search for Spock. Outwitting the M-5 computer or Nomad, and the list goes on.



Using advisors:

Sitting around the triangular table discussing missions, challenges, obstacles, options, dangers, etc.. listening to everyone's viewpoint and debates before reaching a decision.

Bravery:

Kirk had no fear to face adversaries, and had his boots to the ground to lead let alone be involved in most away missions.

Charm/likability:

Accept it or not, James T Kirk had charisma and knew how to employ this not just to gain favors with an attractive female, but to use this characteristic in conjunction with his savvy intelligence to be rather persuasive. He also exhibited a sense of humor that accompanied his sense of duty.

Perspective:

Kirk loved his Enterprise, there is no question about it. Yet he was willing to sacrifice it and if necessary himself along with the crew if deemed a necessity.

When Bele for example, was not satisfied with not being taken to his home world and commandeers the Enterprise by using his mental powers to direct the ship to Cheron, Kirk and under his directive also Spock and Scotty, are forced to activate the three-part self-destruct sequence in order to force Bele to relinquish control of the ship.

He knew when poker should prevail over chess in given situations and acted accordingly, and at times even unconventionally.

8. What is your favorite Star Trek ship?

NCC 1701

9. Other than a captain do you have another favorite Star Trek character?

TOS: Spock and McCoy

10. What is your favorite Star Trek uniform?

Wrath Of Khan

11. What keeps you interested in Star Trek despite the lack of a current episodic series?

The Star Trek Philosophy that Gene Roddenberry envisioned... which could lead to a long and involved discussion in itself.

12. Is there a character or actor you wish had never appeared in Star Trek?

I suppose...but my main complaint is not related to a specific actor but this new "Reboot" of an already rich history of Star Trek.

13. What are your thoughts on J.J. Abrams Star Trek movies?

As we have discussed among members of our fleet here, I am one to also see this as "Star Trek" in name only. No soul or heart...a commercialized version that rushed to have all of the main character meet quickly under forced circumstances and had them acting in manners inconsistent with what was known about them. The timeline and cannon were just thrown away... out of laziness and a selfish "I'll ignore everything out there and just do what I want to do... regardless."

Both movies so far were much more fantasy than true Science Fiction, more silly unbelievable and unnecessary Star Wars-like chase/action sequences and events... then the thought-provoking aspects that we as fans expect and hope for in a Star Trek film. It is like a adventure of glitzy and flashy form, with no real substance beyond the shallow facade. The pilfering from the Wrath of Khan alone was



rather embarrassing and nauseating to witness.... as a long time fan.

However, I don't blame the actors for these atrocities, but rather the weak, superficial writing by Abram's team.

14. *Is there someone else you'd like to see direct a Star Trek film?*

Seth MacFarlane: A true Star Trek fan who has the skills and desire to bring a more genuine approach and integrity back to this franchise.

15. *How do you think we can best apply Gene Roddenberry's vision today?*

By not being a lemming within a closed-minded, self-serving insensitive society. By not allowing insatiable greed to overtake common sense and fairness.

Things will not change in our world unless how we ourselves choose to interact with those around us differently. Like a pay-it-forward approach, we need to emulate in our words and deeds the type of world in which we would like to see exist. Those around you will eventually take notice in some capacity.

16. *Are you active in Star Trek Online?*

Yes... on and off

17. *What is your impression of the game today versus when it launched?*

It is way more advanced and developed than when first launched. I like the episodes that are released. I've enjoyed many sessions of team STFs or PVEs over the years with other Lotus Team members. Having previously been an Events coordinator, I played and replayed many of those episodes time and time again.

Although I have to admit, I was not too keen on STO having gone to FTP after investing \$\$\$ into a Lifetime subscription. Especially since now they want you to continually purchase a slew of different things, which I usually choose not to do. I just allow my Zen to accrue and/or earn dilithium if I need to make any significant purchase.

18. *Do you believe Cryptic stays mostly true to Star Trek's vision?*

Somewhat for a game. Although there is much more combat than diplomacy. But this is an action game so that is not a surprise. Nevertheless, there are trying to incorporate other aspects into the game besides ground or space battles. But then some people complain because they must then think or resolve problems.... which is ironic because this really an integral aspect of the Star Trek philosophy.

19. *What is your passion in life or your biggest aspiration?*

Music. Recording and releasing a series of original CDs. Also writing: both songs and stories, poems etc...

20. *What is your biggest peeve?*

Prejudice and narrow-mindedness

21. *Could you describe yourself in 5 words?*

Creative, Musical, Introspective, Writer, Intelligent

22. *Do you have a personal motto?*

Refer to the answer for question #15.

23. *What advice would you give new members?*

Get involved with any aspect of the fleet in which you have some level of an aptitude. You may find yourself more engaged and invested in the fleet if you become an active part of it... just like in any aspect of life.



24. How would you define leadership?

- Lead by example.
- Allow those around you to shine and demonstrate their perspective and capabilities.
- Don't be power hungry and lead from the top down
- Listen to everyone involved
- Make the work enjoyable during all stages: from inception to completion
- Be willing and open to change
- Continue learning and growing

25. Are there any other thoughts or information that you'd like to add?

Yes, the closest example of those truly striving to follow Roddenberry's vision is the team working on Star Trek Continues.

This is probably the most authentic re-creation of TOS that I have seen. The bridge, sickbay, hallways, Jeffries tube etc... have all been masterfully recreated in amazing detail. The filming, camera angles, music, color, tones, etc... are truly artistic and a real tribute to the original look, feel, sound, and atmosphere of TOS. More importantly, the story-telling aspect is spot on with its integrity, and true to the philosophy and interactions of the Star Trek characters.

Time-wise this series occurs at the start of the 4th season of TOS...had it continued on.

Note: Perhaps the main reason this project is so successful is that this is a project created from the heart and filled with integrity and passion. The positive reactions from hard-core fans to the more casual ones are similar...which is rather unusual but not surprising. People recognize, even if they cannot explain it, a level of quality and authenticity that has been lacking for a long time. Quality is not a fad...it doesn't go out of style. It is sustained now matter how many years, decades, or whatever passes.

It is why Star Trek goes on 50 years after its first pilot was created and will continue, in some form, long after we have perished.

Operations Division wants you!






Follow the adventures of both the USS Horizon and the USS Phoenix as they continue their journeys throughout the cosmos.


From the Ashes

Lieutenant Commander Snowfire K'Leysha, (played by Snowfire) the mysterious Illithyrii chief of science who chiefly helped solve the Azimuth Horizon threat; her impressive telepathic powers will be invaluable in communicating with the Undines.

Lieutenants 011 and 110, (played by Evshell) the only Bynars acting as chief medical officers in Starfleet; best capable of all in understanding and dealing with the unknown organic technology of the Undines and their mysterious realm.

Orion Lieutenant Elisha Leône, (played by Jeff T) chief of operations; living proof of the value of equality, freedom and brotherhood of the Federation.

Romulan Lieutenant S'Tan Solius (Played by Niomo) chief engineer; also proving by his sole presence that Starfleet and the Federation can and do make peace and friendship even with former enemies.

Lieutenant First Class Alexandria Somers, (played by AlexSomers) Marines commander; with her combination of military and diplomatic skills and elite team of specially-trained soldiers, may best ensure that the Horizon and her crew will return home.

On this important mission, the perils match the promises. The USS Horizon and her crew are about to embark on their historical journey. Will they succeed?



STO UPDATE BY ADMIRAL ATHOS

Well done Lotus Fleet! Our efforts and the overall strategy are showing big results. First and foremost, our Dilithium Mine is now maximized at Tier 3; make certain to check out the now-open second level! Maxing out the Dilithium Mine Holding gives Lotus Fleet a 15% discount on Fleet Marks, Dilithium and Commodities required to complete all projects. We are also working on the Rich Dilithium Mining Daily Mission project; this allows each player to mine a large amount of ore. If it is like the Vlugta Asteroid Field Rich Dilithium VIP claim (5,000 dilithium in 1 minute), it will be quite worth your time.

Our Embassy is upgraded to Tier 2. After we finish the construction project that enables instant transport to the Embassy from any of the other Fleet facilities (Dilithium Mine, Starbase, Spire?), we will start to upgrade the Trade Facility to tier 2.

Our Starbase is at Tier 3; it takes quite a lot to get any of the facilities to upgrade to tier 4, but your hard work has our Comm Array at over half-way to Tier 4. We only need 21,000 more points, upgrade the Comm Array, then we can upgrade our Starbase to Tier 4. It is a slow process, but remember the ultimate goal is to provide Lotus Fleet members with access to the best ships and gear, both space and ground.

Finally, we have started our Fleet Spire. Progress will be quick at first as we build the Spire through Tier 1. Remember that there are cosmetic upgrades to all of our facilities, except the Starbase, which you can contribute towards. As recent events have shown, a team effort working under an overall strategy towards a specific purpose will yield results.
